Day 1: Lisbon, Portugal - Tour Begins

Your tour begins in Lisbon, Portugal's gracious capital. You are at leisure to relax or explore independently.

Day 2: Lisbon - Fatima

A leisurely ride through picturesque landscapes brings you to Fatima, the world-famous religious centre. *(B, D)*

Day 3: Fatima

Join the local parishioners in celebrating Mass before exploring the Basilica to see the Tombs of Francisco and Jacinta and its grounds. ▶▶ **Travel to Aljustrel, where the children lived, and the Valinhos, where Our Lady appeared after the children's return from prison.**▶▶ This afternoon, travel to one of the most picturesque spots in all of Portugal, the coastal village of Nazare. Witness the architectural splendour of the massive Alcobaca Monastery. This evening, enjoy time for devotion and worship. *(B, D)*

Day 4: Fatima - Burgos, Spain

Attend the early morning Mass before travelling east to Burgos, known as the cradle of the Castile region. The town stands on the banks of the Rio Arlanzón with the slender, elegant spires of its famous cathedral rising into the sky. Upon arrival, visit the Cathedral of Burgos, the third largest church in Spain. *(B, D)*

Day 5: Burgos - Lourdes, France

Mass is available before you travel northeast through the Pyrenees to Lourdes. This is where the Virgin Mary appeared in the Grotto of Massabielle to the poor shepherd girl, Bernadette, a total of 18 times between February 11 - July 16, 1858. This little market town has been a pilgrimage site of world renown ever since. Tonight you may wish to partake in a candlelight procession. *(B, D)*

Day 6: Lourdes

▶▶ **After morning Mass enjoy a walking tour of Lourdes, visiting the places associated with the life of St. Bernadette: the Holy Hill, the local mill, the parish church and the "Cachot", the chapel where she received Holy Communion.**▶▶ Later, at leisure, explore the town's rich historical and natural heritage and be submerged in the atmosphere that reigned during the apparitions and the spirit of brotherhood that is still present today. *(CB, L, D)*

Day 7: Lourdes - Carcassone - Barcelona, Spain

Celebrate Mass before travelling through southern France's Pyrenees Mountains to Carcassone. Enjoy some leisure time to explore this beautiful, historic town and its medieval atmosphere. Later, cross back into Spain and travel to fascinating Barcelona, one of Europe's most popular cities. *(CB)*

Day 8: Barcelona

Get an in-depth look at Barcelona with a tour that showcases Las Ramblas Boulevard, Columbus Monument, Parc Montjuic, Mila House and Parc Guell. Your tour concludes with a visit to Antonio Gaudi's masterpiece, "La Sagrada Familia." The afternoon is at leisure for independent exploration or you may join an optional excursion to the quaint mountain village of Montserrat. This evening, join your fellow travellers for a dinner celebrating the end of a memorable tour. *(B, D)*

Day 9: Barcelona

Your day is at leisure to explore the city or do some last minute shopping. *(B)*

Uniquely Collette Burgos...land of cathedrals

Burgos was founded in 884, and its historical heritage is immediately evident.

Admittedly, its main sights are ecclesiastical, most notably the cathedral itself, but it is an atmospheric place and has a rare grandeur and medieval northern Castilian ambience.

The Cathedral of Burgos, completed in 1222, is among the most admired of its kind worldwide. Especially remarkable are its portal, the "Puerta del Sarmental," considered the best example of gothic sculpture of its century. The Cathedral of Burgos is modeled after the French cathedral of Bourges and reflects the Gothic style made popular in Spain by the Cistercian Order. The Monasterio de las Huelgas, with its gothic chapterhouse of unique value and its Romanesque cloister, is considered one of the most important monuments in Spain. It was founded in 1187 by Alfonso VIII whose tomb, alongside those of other members of the Spanish royal family, can be visited inside.

After sightseeing, you may want to try out Burgos' exquisite cuisine. The most famous food of Burgos is the fresh cheese with slight goat-milk-flavor, called "Queso de Burgos."
